Sept. Election for CPAAA Officers

The CPAAA By-laws were amended in 2008, shifting the Elections from May to September. The positions of officers were also redefined. Instead of co-chairpersons, we will now have a president and vice-president. Nominations will be taken at the July and August meetings. Please consider nominating yourself or another CPAAA Member for the 2009-2010 term. Ballots will be mailed to all Members after the August meeting. All ballots must be returned by the Sept. 1 meeting.

President and Vice-President: preside over meetings of the Board of Directors and general membership meetings; serve as liaisons for the Alumni Association to the MPD administration; have the power to appoint, with approval of the Board of Directors, such persons as deemed necessary to assist the Board of Directors and the President and Vice President in carrying out the affairs of the Alumni Association.

Secretary: keep and maintain the minutes of the general membership meetings, type them, and present them at the next general meeting; handle all correspondence to members, outside agencies, guest speakers, and community.

Treasurer: keep and maintain an accurate past and current record of all financial affairs of the Alumni Association, and make a full report of its finances at all meetings of the general membership; collect dues, make deposits, prepare a "bank" for fund raisers and deliver it to the chair of the fund raising committee; apply for any permits necessary for the organization though town hall, or other proper agencies.

An FID card will be required before you can received your pepper spray unit.

Completed applications along with firearms safety course certificates (if applicable) must be submitted to the Mashpee Police Station one week prior to the date you return for the fingerprinting and photograph process.
